Currently managed by the fourth-generation owners Lee Wah Kooi and Lee Wah Chai, Swatow Lane's Ais Kacang is steeped in history and a part of Penang's rich heritage.</li> <li>- <b>Penang Laksa</b>, another Penang favourite, can also be found at their stall. Penang Laksa typically consists of thick wheat noodles or rice vermicelli with shredded fish, and finely sliced vegetables including cucumber, onions, red chillies, pineapple, lettuce and mint, served in spicy soup based on sour assam (tamarind) and topped with a thick sweet prawn-shrimp paste.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
